This event is registered as part of “The Last Post” which is “a mass participation project taking place in cities, towns and villages across the UK in November 2014.

Hundreds of people will unite in communities around the nation to remember the impact that the First World War had on their local community and play music from the era as a mark of commemoration.

At every event, the Last Post bugle call will be played to remember people in their community, not just on bugles but on any instrument from piano to bagpipes, guitar to steel drums. It is a powerful ceremonial call which Last Post participants can make their own as part of a shared community experience.”
